Some 250 slave plots and revolts fueled Whites’ fears of Black insurrection (Katz, 1990) White fears rose as the slave population grew from 700,000

in 1790 to 4 million in 1860 (Schlesinger, 1993) Beginning in the 1670s, governing bodies in the slave-holding states responded to these fears with creation of slave codes

symbolized and reconfirmed white patriarchy It was sadistic, erotic, and a repetitious cycle fueled by the legal structures and political economies of slave societies Eventually it manifested into commerce of rape whereby white men could purchase enslaved women for the primary purpose of fulfilling their sexual desires and fantasies

exceptional as only free white women received exemptions from paying county tithes The second event was a court case held in 1655 whereby Anthony sued a white neighbor, Robert Parker, over a black slave, John Casor Casor claimed he entered Virginia as an indentured servant, and his contract had ended seven years ago making him a free man
