B Norms make social life possible by making behavior predictable Without norms, social chaos would exist The reason deviance is seen as threatening is because it undermines predictability Thus, social control (the formal and informal means of enforcing norms) is necessary for social life
C When a norm is violated, sanctions are imposed 1

Deviance and Social Control

- Deviance is present in all societies
- Deviance is normal so long as it is not excessive
- Deviance will be present even in a “community of saints”

Little faults and flaws will be magnified to the same scandalousness as serious offenses, and thus will become known as crimes Durkheim on Deviance

Anomie-social condition in which norms are weak, conflicting, or absent Strain Theory-deviance is more likely to occur when a gap exists between cultural goals, and the ability to achieve them Control Theory-theory that compliance with social norms requires strong bonds between individuals and society
