Establishing the Shelf Life of Pharmaceutical Products

The PQRI Stability Shelf Life (SSL) Working Group was formed in late 2006 to investigate current and alternative statistical methods for estimating the shelf life of pharmaceutical products with stability data The interest in alternative methods was stimulated by several factors: (1) the need to make statistical approaches more
