INTRODUCTION Drug-impaired driving is an increasingly critical issue for states and state highway safety offices In 2015, the most recent year for which data are available, NHTSA's Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS) reported that drugs were present in 43% of the fatally-injured drivers with a known test result, more frequently than alcohol was present (FARS, 2016)
