The Humane Methods of Slaughter Act of 1958 was the first federal law governing the handling of livestock in meat plants The 1958 law applied only to livestock slaughtered for sale to the government In 1978, the Humane Methods of Slaughter Act was reauthorized to cover all livestock slaughtered in federally inspected meat plants
