Planning Effective Educational Programs for Adult ...

key concept Making educational program relevant to the learner by recognizing the unique background and incorporating adult learners' experience into education is important Adult learners need to know that new knowledge is relevant to their job, their family, and their life (Knowles, 1990)

with ADL skills 21 Seek advice and recommendations from a physical therapist regarding suitable positioning for the client 22 Arrange for the client to obtain necessary adaptive and/or physical therapy equipment 23 Develop a skills acquisition program designed to teach feeding, bathing, grooming, and/or dressing skills
