Jan 01, 1993 · Lifting beams, Lifting frames and Lifting spreaders are a means of providing two or more lifting points from the hook of the lifting machine or crane spaced so as to match the position of the lifting points on the load The difference lies in the way the forces are transmitted A lifting beam is loaded in bending
