Whereas, 5 km by underground would emit $1,000,000 \times 0.068 \times 5 = 340$ tonnes CO₂ This saves 640 tonnes of CO₂ for those 5 km That's a good economics A 15 m up escalator, running for the typical 20 hours service each day on the London Underground, produces 220 kg of CO₂ $(102 + 2) \times 0.9 \times 20 \approx 220$ kg = 0.22 tonnes CO₂
