Luria's organization of the brain into functional units accounts for cultural influences on higher cognition as well as biological factors He stated that "perception and memorizing, gnosis and praxis, speech and thinking, writing, reading and arithmetic, cannot be regarded as isolated or even indivisible 'faculties' " (Luria, 1973b, p 29)
