Oedipus at Colonus (also Oedipus Coloneus, Ancient Greek: Οιδίππους ἐπὶ Κολωνῶν, Oidipous epi Kolōnōi) is one of the three Theban plays of the Athenian tragedian Sophocles. It was written shortly before Sophocles's death in 406 BC and produced by his grandson (also called Sophocles) at the Festival of Dionysus in 401 BC.
